According to the City of Tucson Housing and Community Development Department, Tucson has seen an increase in the homeless population since 2019. As of 2020, "the population increased in Pima County by 20.9% from 1,372 in 2019 to 1,660 in 2020."

The poverty rate in Tucson is 24.1%. One out of every 4.2 residents of Tucson lives in poverty.

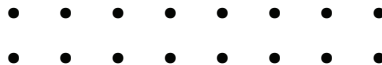

Saw approximately 300 people in attendance.

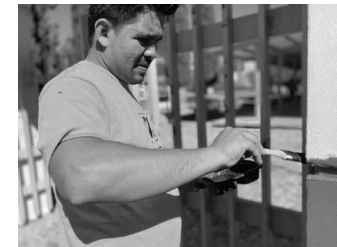

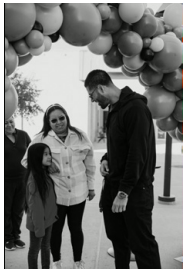
